Administrative Update

Staff reported that CSB is not yet reporting the 80/20 revenue split. Our CSB rep is new and she didn't have an answer on why this issue has not been fixed. Staff will follow up with their supervisor when she returns to the office later this month. Staff also reported all FY19 grants have been closed out and paid.

Staff conducted an initial training audit and reported 18 constables have not met the minimum statutory requirement for training in calendar year 2019. Ten of those constables have not reported any training. Staff reached out to the AZ Constables Association to determine if those constables are still in their positions. The Board directed staff to send the customary courtesy letters letting constables know they are deficient and have until December 31, 2019 to complete the training.

The motion passed 3-1 with Constable Blake voting no.

Complaint received 10-10-19 Huckelberry vs Vasquez - Chairman Cobb introduced the complaint which was initiated by Pima County against the constable due to his continued issues with his vehicle use and failure to report accidents/damage. Valerie Beckett made a motion to move forward with an investigation and Judge Dowling seconded. \Discussion: Concern was raised that this is a county issue, not and ethics board issue, and therefore should not move forward with the formal complaint process. It was pointed out that an investigation will help determine that.

Adjournment: Constable Blake made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Valerie Beckett seconded. The motion passed unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 10:45 a.m.
