**MINUTES**

*December 9, 2014*

A subcommittee committee meeting of the Constable Ethics, Standards and Training Board (CESTB) was called to order by Constable Scott Tipton at 10:07 a.m. on December 9, 2014. The meeting was held in the Capitol Consulting boardroom at 818 North First Street, Phoenix AZ 85004. Members participating in the meeting included Constable Tipton, members participating by teleconference included Constable Nozar and Christine Shipley. Also present was staff Tracy Unmacht, public Jason Brown, and CBS5 News Reporter Jason Berry.

The following matters were discussed, considered and decided at the meeting:

**Discussion & Possible Recommendation for Open Investigation\***

**CNA124-2014 - Clark:** Constable Tipton informed the sub-committee that Constable Clark had not received the original notice of this hearing, but found out about it and sent an email to the committee on December 8<sup>th</sup> indicating his desire to be kept informed. He didn't express any interest in attending today's hearing, and Constable Tipton confirmed with subcommittee members that they would proceed with the hearing under these circumstances. Constable Tipton confirmed the subcommittee members had received copies of the complaint and supporting materials and confirmed with subcommittee members that there wasn't any new information that had been received since they last met to discuss this case. Constable Nozar made a motion to recommend to the CESTB Board that a letter of reprimand be sent to Constable Clark. Christine Shipley seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
